## **EXCURSION**

Want to experience the work of our sanctuary first-hand? Come visit us!

Excursions are only run July 1st - February 28th

Excursions typically run for 1.5-2 hours, and begin with a presentation about our sanctuary and the ecological importance of dingos. After the presentation, one of our friendly ambassador dingos will give a live demonstration of the differences between dingos and dogs. We will then move to the exercise yards, where students will spend 15 minutes watching our furry-friends do their dingo thing. This is a great time to ask questions, so get those gears turning! The session concludes with some stories from our volunteers, and a browse through the gift shop.

**Duration**: 1.5-2 hours per session, limit of 1 session per day.

**Operation:** Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00am.

**Capacity**: Strictly 15 attendees per session (including staff). **Requirements**: Own transport. The sanctuary is only suitable to mini buses, vans or cars. The sanctuary is not accessible via public transport. Attendees <u>must</u> wear closed toe shoes, long pants and clothing that can get dirty (more information is available on the website). Age limit 7yrs+.

## INCURSION

Dingos are home-bodies, but our humans love educating far and wide!

Our dingoes can travel hundreds of kilometres by foot, but they aren't so enthusiastic about cars.

Our humans are though! Our one-hour sessions cover topics such as Indigenous significance, specialised anatomy, Pre- and post-European history, ecological niche, social behaviour and threats. Our videos will demonstrate the differences between dingo's and dogs, and highlight a dingo's super senses! Students will have the opportunity to win some dingo merch during the session, as well as being presented with a plush dingo to keep as a class pet.

**Time**: 60 minutes per session, no session limit per day.

**Operation:** Tuesdays from 9:00am **Capacity**: No audience size limit

**Requirements**: A presentation space/classroom, HDMI compatible projector/screen, microphone if needed. Please let our staff know if you do not have access to any of this equipment.
